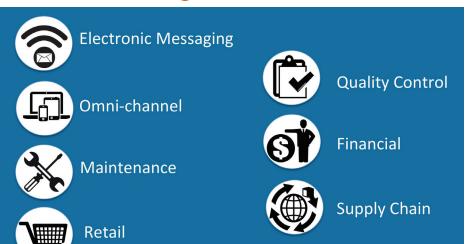
enVista's enHanced Integration Framework (EIF) was designed to solve integration issues between Dynamics AX and external systems and replaces Microsoft's Application Integration Framework (AIF). EIF provides the flexibility to configure, execute and manage custom integrations. EIF is not targeted towards a specific external system, but rather it is AX-centric, which gives Dynamics AX users more flexibility within their ERP environment. EIF supports several versions of Dynamics AX, including AX7.

What is EIF?

- A proven method to provide a solution to the many integration problems
- The ability to work with virtually any data in the system

- Message integration including: File system (CSV, Flat File), Direct Database Connection, REST API and SOAP API
- Built-in cross-reference framework that allows the user to apply various value mappings to a single transaction set

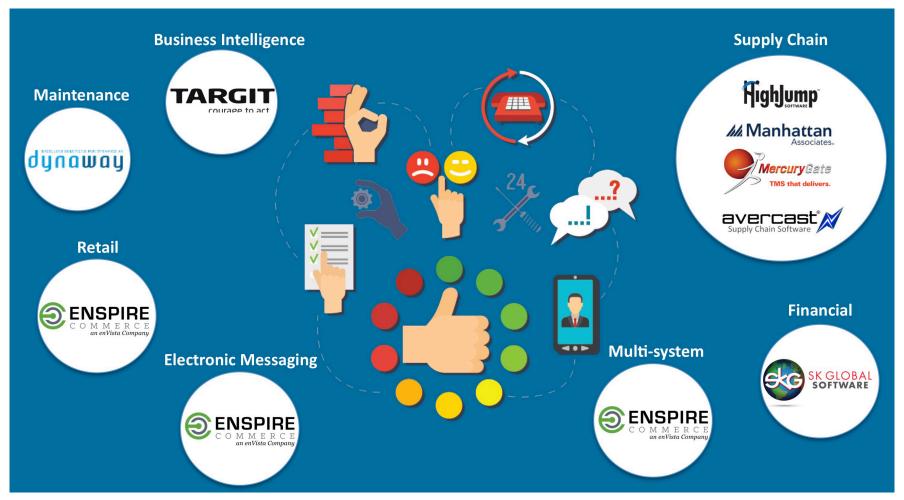
